Welfare Rights Info

Wolverhampton Welfare Rights Service.

We provide a Welfare Rights Service including a Welfare Rights Officer in each social work team, offering advice to staff and a specialist case work referral service. Our Take - Up Team targets Home Support and other vulnerable potential users to maximise benefits. Social Care and Health staff are trained by the WRS to offer benefits advice to service users. In the last 12 months benefits gains totalled £3.19m. We work jointly with local and national benefits administering authorities and have a Joint Partnership Agreement with the Local Pension Service. We have also undertaken a pilot one day per week WRS jointly with the NHS Trust and the Macmillan Support and Information Centre for people with Cancer which will be developed in the coming year. This service has achieved benefit gains (potential and actual) of £467.4k. £917.2k funding is also provided for voluntary organisations providing welfare benefits advice including, CAB, Age Concern and Blakenhall Community Advice Centre.
