
Completing a form electronically



Using Adobe Acrobat Reader Fill and Sign


1. In your web browser, search for "adobe reader":



Alternatively, go straight to https://get.adobe.com/uk/reader/:




2. Click "Download Acrobat Reader" and follow the onscreen instructions:



3. Open the PDF file you want to fill in electronically:




4. Choose "Fill & Sign" from the list of tools on the right side of the screen:



5. When asked "What do you want to do?" click "Fill and sign":



6. You should now see this toolbar appear at the top of the screen:



7. Select Add Text and place the cursor where you want to start typing or to add a symbol – Adobe Reader should automatically lock onto the closest line when you click:




If you need to move a text box, point the arrow at the edge of the box and this symbol will appear. Hold down the left mouse button and drag the text box to a new location.


8. The following tools appear above the text box:



9. To add your signature, click Sign then Add Signature and Image. Browse your computer to find and select the picture of your signature:



10. Your signature will now appear on the page as a floating object. Move it where you want it to go and click it into place. Click, hold and drag this button to resize your signature.



11. Don't forget to save your completed form; the save button is in the top left corner:
